Larry L. Ross Sr., 66, of Camanche died Saturday, October 16, 2010 at Mercy Medical Center. Funeral services will be 10:00am Tuesday, October 19, 2010 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Clinton. Visitation will be from 4:00-7:00pm Monday, October 18, 2010 at the Camanche Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory. Cremation rites will follow the funeral service.
