Thomas J. Powell, 80, of Camanche passed away, Friday, December 10, 2021 at his home after a courageous battle with cancer.

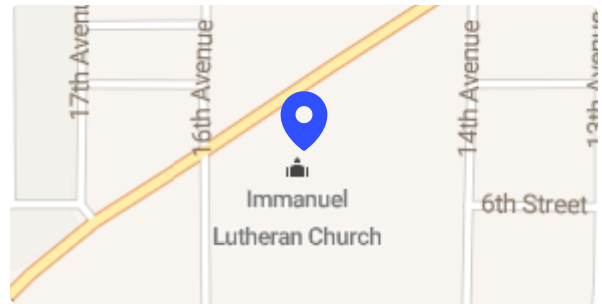

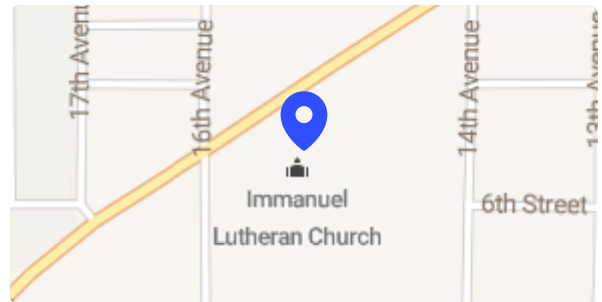
