Memorials can be made to the Alverno.

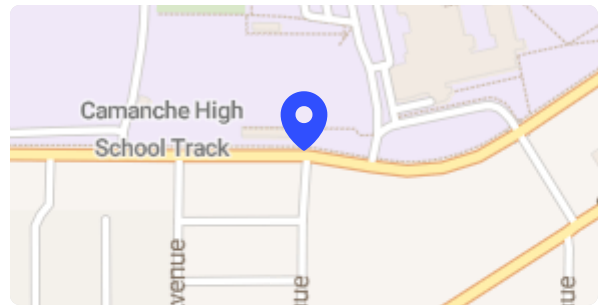

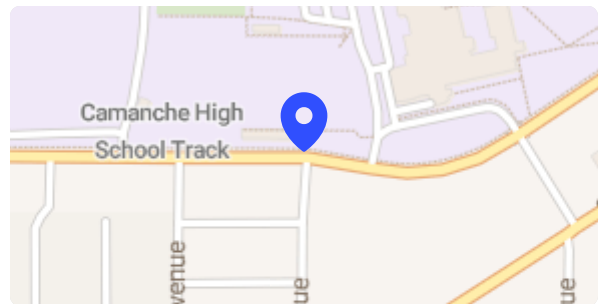
