Earl G. Buelow, 91, of Camanche passed away Friday, March 4, 2022 at The Alverno – Clinton.

Funeral Mass will be 11:00 am Monday, March 14, 2022 at Church of the Visitation Catholic Church in Camanche. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers will be his grandsons. 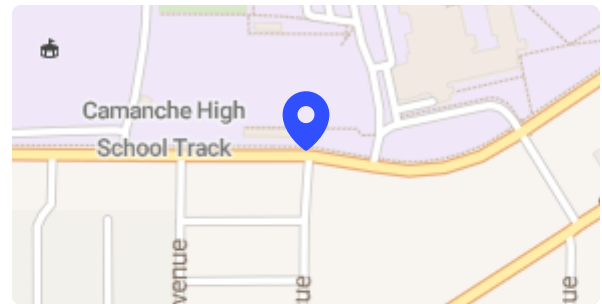

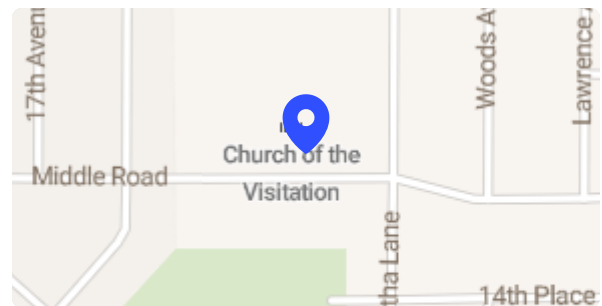

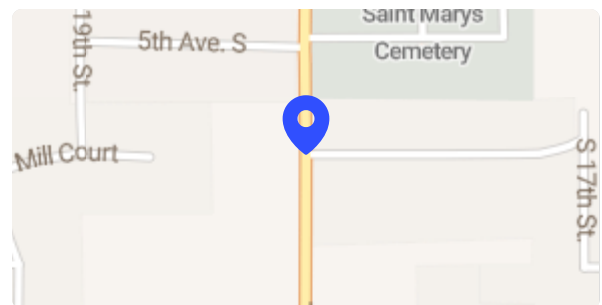
