Larry J. Maring, 71, of Camanche passed away Tuesday, June 14, 2022 at University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.

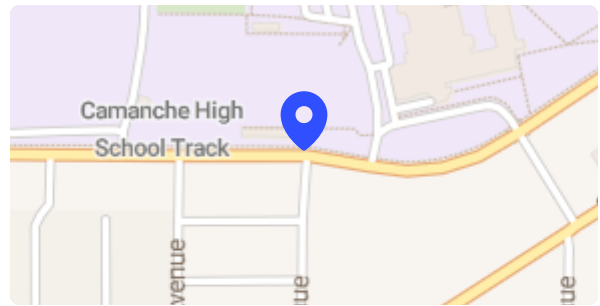

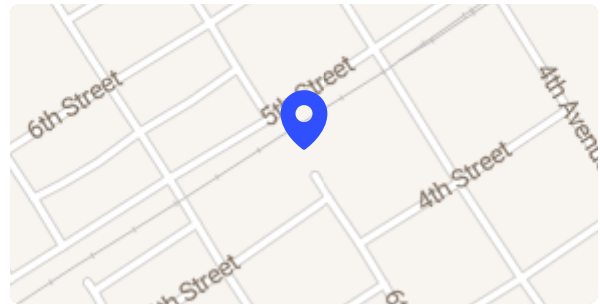
