Willis “Willie” Lee Carroll, 80, of Morrison, Illinois, passed away Sunday, June 19, 2022 at his home in Morrison. 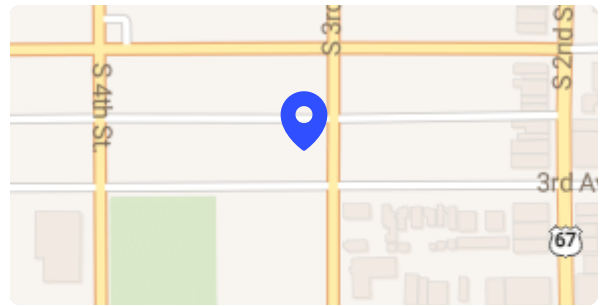
