Melvin Steffey, 98, of Clinton, IA, passed away Wednesday, July 20, 2022 at his home in Clinton. 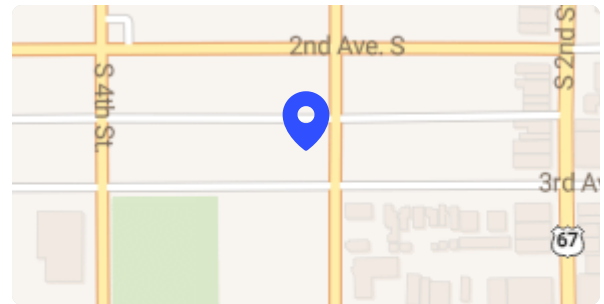

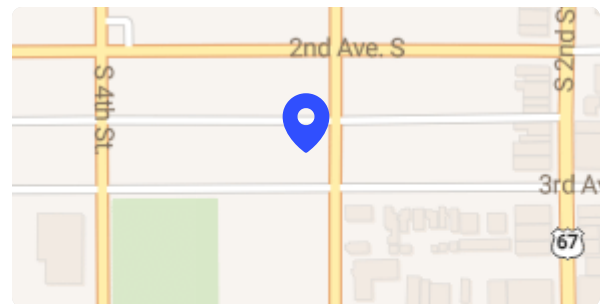

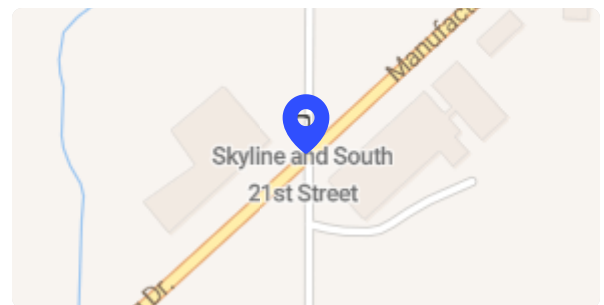
