Craig S. Johnson, 53, of Clinton, died Friday, November 30, 2012 at his home.

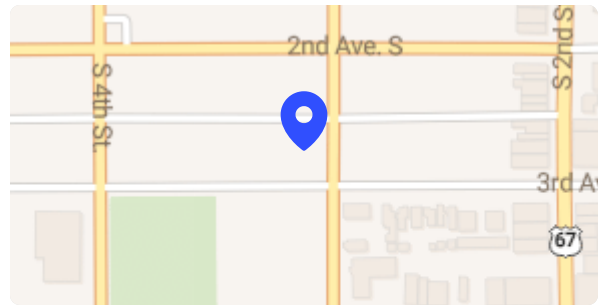
