The family requests that memorials may be made to Mercy Living Center south.




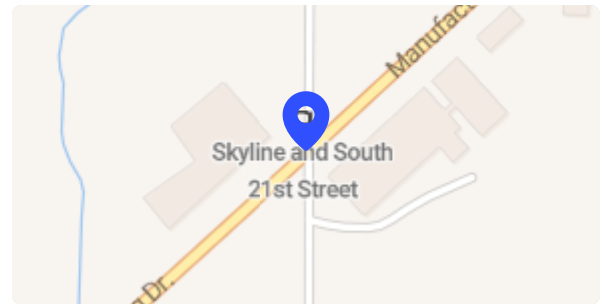
