Mary Jo Witt, 93, of Clinton passed away, Sunday, February 18, 2024 at Bickford.

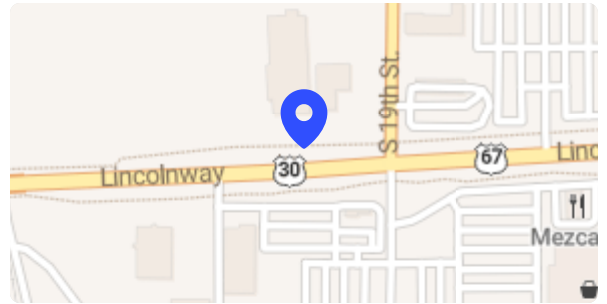
