William Abram Weber was born on October 7, 1931 in Camanche, the son of William H. and Margaret E. (Keller) Weber. He served in the United States Army during Korean Conflict. He was decorated with the Korean Service Medal, the Bronze Star and the Purple Heart for his service to our country.

Bill was employed at ALCOA in the box shop from 1949 until his retirement in 1993. He was active with the Korean War Veterans Association in Moline. He was avid Iowa Hawkeye, Green Bay Packer, and St. Louis Cardinals fan. He will be remembered for his one-liners and witty sense of humor. He loved spending time with his family.

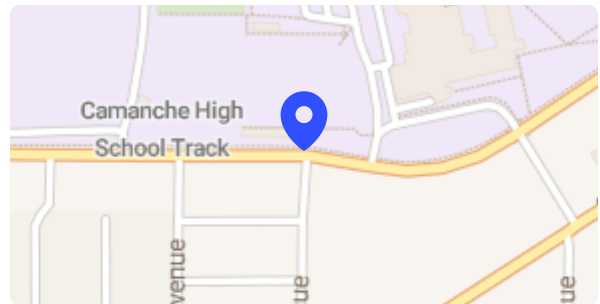

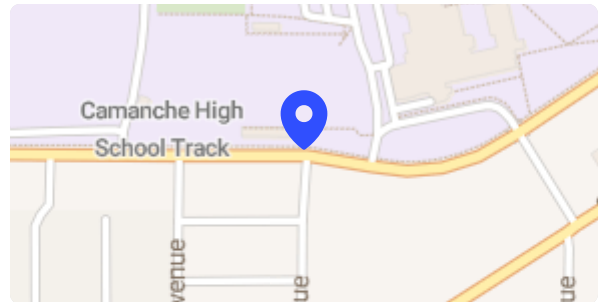
