Judy A. Carstensen, 76, of Clinton, passed away, Sunday, November 24, 2024 at her home.

Judy Ann Senior was born on November 18, 1948 in Morrison, Illinois, the daughter of Harvey and Lena (Boelkens) Senior. 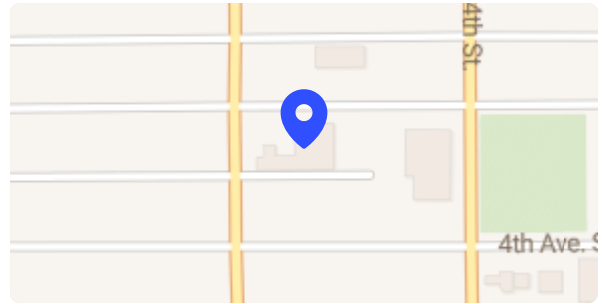

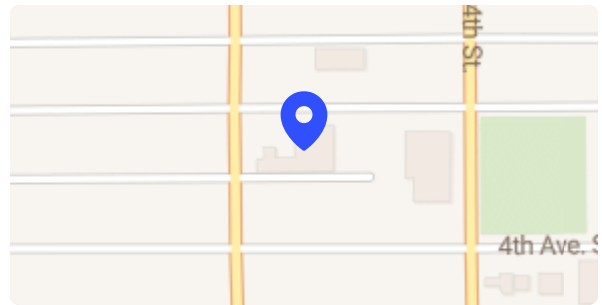
