He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, and his siblings: Sally, Kirby and Ronald. He will be sorely missed by his family, friends and community.

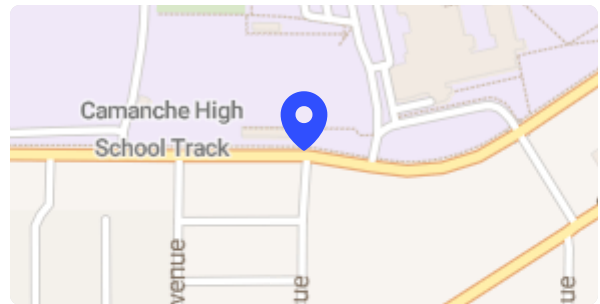
