Shirley L. Walters, 88, of Camanche passed away Sunday, July 6, 2025 at UnityPoint Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines, Iowa.

Friends and family are welcome to stop by the Camanche Community Center on Monday, July 14, from 3 to 8 PM to celebrate Shirley’s life and her family.

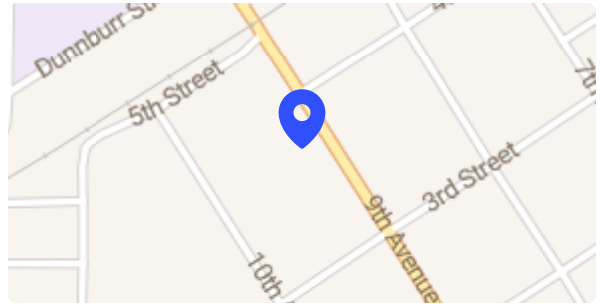
