He was preceded in death by his father in 2001 and friend Dan Mussman.

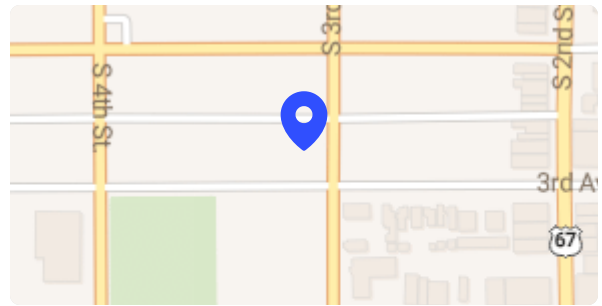

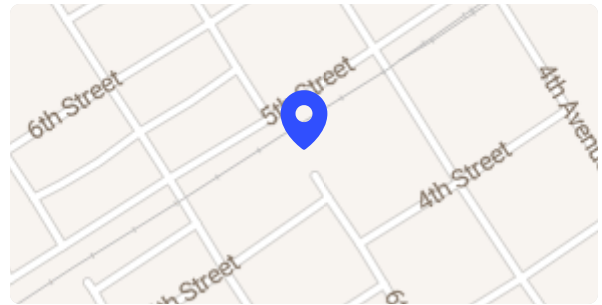

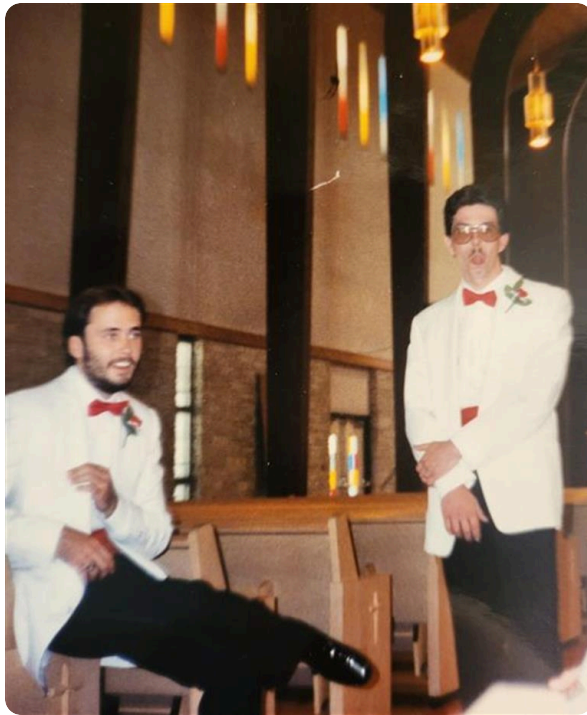
