Dorothy Truninger, 95, of Clinton, passed away at home, Friday, January 9, 2026.

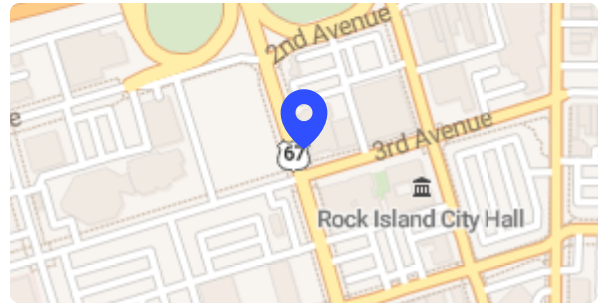
