He was preceded in death by his parents, and his brother-in-law: Tom McKenzie.

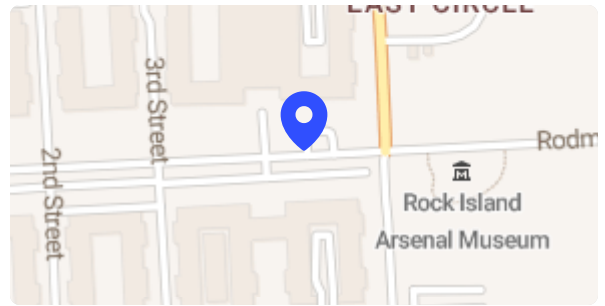
