Memorials may be made to the Lighthouse Baptist Church, Camanche.

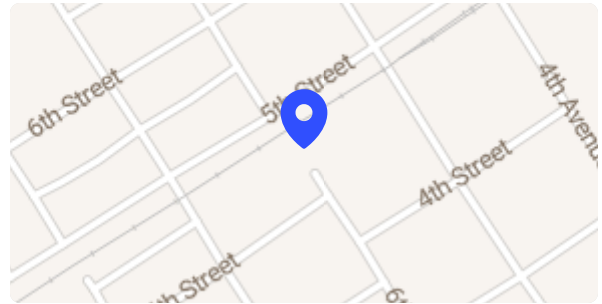
