Above all else, Jack was a devoted family man and an exceptional father to his three children. Being present for his family was his greatest priority, and he took immense pride in supporting them in all they did. 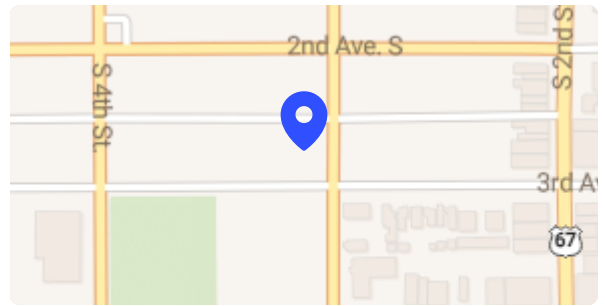

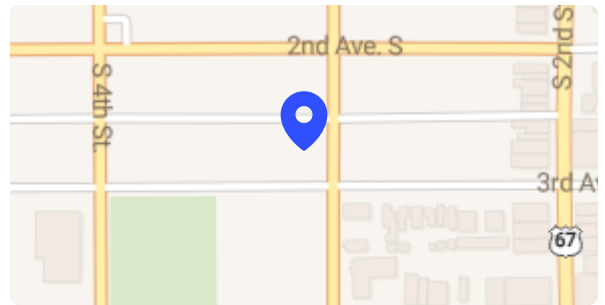
