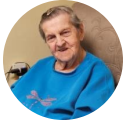

Betty had a great appetite. She loved going out to eat with family. She had a passion for buffets and all you can eat smorgasbords. She was loved and adored by many.



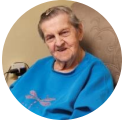
