He will be in our hearts. Forever.



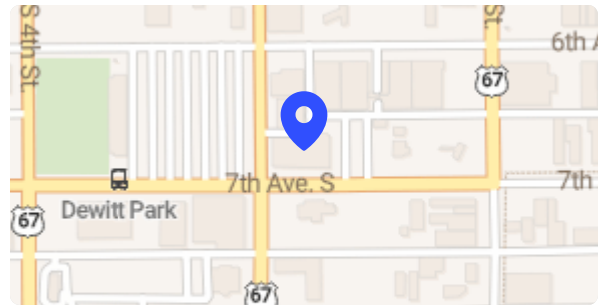

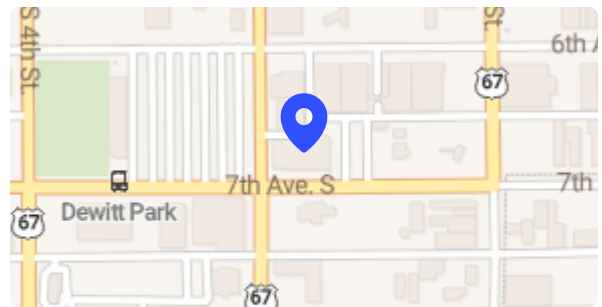
